<b>Level 1 – Entering</b>			<b>Nivel 1 – Ingresando</b>
<b>Linguistic Complexity</b>	• use one word or a memorized chunk.		<b>Complejidad Lingüística</b>
<b>Vocabulary</b>	• use only the most common words.		<b>Vocabulario</b>
<b>Language Control</b>	• be easy to understand memorized pieces. • only talk /write about everyday things.		<b>Control del Lenguaje</b>
<b>Level 2 – Emerging</b>			<b>Nivel 2 – Emergiendo</b>
<b>Linguistic Complexity</b>	• use a phrase or short sentence. • usually use correct sentence structure.		<b>Complejidad Lingüística</b>
<b>Vocabulary</b>	• use common words about subject. • often have trouble thinking of a word or a way to say something .		<b>Vocabulario</b>
<b>Language Control</b>	• talk/write in simple, short sentences or phrases. • be hard understand when trying to use longer sentences.		<b>Control del Lenguaje</b>
<b>Level 3 – Developing</b>			<b>Nivel 3 – Desarrollando</b>
<b>Linguistic Complexity</b>	• use longer sentences. • <b>add details</b> . • use correct sentence structure.		<b>Complejidad Lingüística</b>
<b>Vocabulary</b>	• use some content language. • may have trouble finding a certain word or phrase.		<b>Vocabulario</b>
<b>Language Control</b>	• use sentences that are clear and easy to understand. • have mistakes with harder language that make me sometimes hard to understand.		<b>Control del Lenguaje</b>
<b>Level 4 – Expanding</b>			<b>Nivel 4 – Expandiendo</b>
<b>Linguistic Complexity</b>	• use <b>different types of sentences</b> . • talk/write with many details. • use <b>paragraph structure</b> . • can be understood.		<b>Complejidad Lingüística</b>
<b>Vocabulary</b>	• use content /subject area vocabulary. • sometimes have trouble finding a certain word or phrase.		<b>Vocabulario</b>
<b>Language Control</b>	• usually be easy to understand. • sometimes make grammar mistakes.		<b>Control del Lenguaje</b>
<b>Level 5 – Bridging</b>			<b>Nivel 5 – Cruzando</b>
<b>Linguistic Complexity</b>	• use many types and lengths of sentences. • talk <b>in-depth</b> about a subject or <b>write many paragraphs</b> . • use details to support a main idea.		<b>Complejidad Lingüística</b>
<b>Vocabulary</b>	• use content vocabulary. • use the correct word without stumbling- most of the time.		<b>Vocabulario</b>
<b>Language Control</b>	• make the kind of mistakes that native English speakers make.		<b>Control del Lenguaje</b>
