STUDENTNET & ILP: FACT SHEET*

What is StudentNet?

StudentNet is the District's online portal for students to view their own academic record and to access high quality resources for planning their paths to graduation and beyond. Its purpose is to empower students with their own information and resources they need to achieve success. StudentNet is available to ALL students, grades K-12, enrolled in the School District of Philadelphia. Students who have withdrawn or dropped out can access StudentNet once they re-enroll in a District school.

StudentNet provides students with access to the following:

- ❖ Academic record: grades, credits earned, attendance, grade point average, and standardized test scores from the 2001-2002 school year-present
- Individual Learning Plan: (see below)
- * Textbooks: nearly all District Core Curriculum textbooks are available online
- ❖ Learning Toolbox: video tutorials, PSSA prep guides, resources for Internet research, and more.
- Resources and Tools: information about selecting a high school, career/college planning, jobs, internships, after-school and summer programs, alternative pathways to graduation, social support services, and more.

What is the Individual Learning Plan?

The Individual Learning Plan (ILP) is a personalized document that students develop with their counselors and other supportive adults to develop goals for a successful pathway in life after graduation; to chart their progress toward meeting these goals during each school year; and, to determine what resources and tools they need to reach these goals. Students can access and update their ILPs at any time by logging into their accounts in StudentNet.

Both StudentNet and the ILP are available to ALL District students, grades K-12. For the 2010-11 school year, the requirement is that Counselors and other school staff work with all students in grades 4th through12th to develop an Individual Learning Plan and access StudentNet on a regular basis.

How Do Students Access StudentNet and the ILP?

Students need their student ID# and password to access StudentNet. Counselors provide students with their StudentNet passwords. Students log-in to StudentNet by going to www.philasd.org, clicking on "Login" at the top of the page, and entering their student ID # and password in the blue "Student" box. High school students who are first-time users will click on "Register for an Account" and follow the prompts.

Once in StudentNet, there is a tab on the main page for students to access their ILPs.

Do Parents Have Access?

Parents and Guardians can view their child's academic records and ILP in FamilyNet. To register for an account in FamilyNet, parents/guardians need their child's date of birth and student ID number.
