Late to school	30 –minute detention
Late to school after 9:00 a.m.	60-minute detention
Leaving school without permission	2 days of in-house suspension
Using cell phone	Cell phone is confiscated; parent/guardian must pick it up the following Wednesday between 2:00 and 3:00.
Uniform Violation (Uniform-shirt only or non uniform)	¹ / ₂ hour detention or IHS
Using ipod (Listening to music outside of the lunchroom)	
Not reporting to room 001 when alert goes off in the morning	1 day of In-house Suspension
Classroom disruption (talking, not following directions, etc.)	30-minute detention
Hallwalking without a note	30-minute detention
Fighting	3 days out-of-school suspension

Other policies:

- 1. Absence notes should be given to Ms. Rainey in room 112.
- 2. Late notes from doctor, college, probation officer, court, funeral that is on official letterhead ONLY should be given to room 001. (Handwritten notes are not accepted.)
- 3. When a student's alert goes off in the morning when a student scans in, they must report to room 001 immediately.
- 4. If a student is sick, they must see the nurse. Students may only leave if a parent or guardian picks them up. They may NOT leave by themselves.
- 5. Early releases will be completed by Ms. Rainey in Room 112 for most incidents. Early releases for discipline problems may be completed by Room 001.
