Dear Parent/Guardian:

It is with great sadness that I inform you of the passing of a member of our school community, Kevin Maldonado, an 11th grade student, who died from an accident on June 1, 2016.

A sudden loss like this can have an affect on students. For that reason, we encourage you to listen to your son or daughter as well as discuss with them their feelings and reactions to this tragedy. Sudden death is always painful to understand, and your child may experience signs of stress. These include:

- Inability to concentrate
- Irritability or increased aggression
- Isolation and withdrawal from normal activities and friends
- Guilt
- Fearfulness and worries
- Changes in sleep or appetite

Today, The School District of Philadelphia's Emergency/Crisis Response Team was onsite to counsel and support students throughout the school day. A team of professional counselors was also available to speak with children individually and meet with others in groups as needed.
