Identifies the health, safety, disabilities, mental health and nutrition needs of the community and the families the program serves

Assists in identifying resources for health, safety, disabilities, mental health and nutritional issues and making those resources available to families, staff and the community

Identifies health, safety, disabilities, mental health and nutritional educational needs and assists in child, staff and parent training in the identified areas

Identifies resources for referral and assistance when issues arise

Acts as an advocate for children and families in the areas of health, safety, disabilities, mental health and nutrition
