The School District is requiring for this school year that schools work with all students from grades 4-12 to use StudentNet and to develop an ILP. - Ask your child to log-in to StudentNet with you so you can explore it together

- Contact your child's school Counselor to ask questions, seek help, and/or share any updates to the ILP that you and your child have made together
- [FOR GRADES K-8] If your child forgot his/her password, please contact the School Counselor
- [FOR GRADES 9-12] If your child forgot his/her temporary password, please contact the School Counselor. If your child forgot his/her re-set password, go to the log-in page at <a href="www.philasd.org/login">www.philasd.org/login</a> and click on "Forgot Your Password?" in the blue "Student" box. If your child also forgot the answers to the security questions, ask the School Counselor to contact the District Helpdesk (215-400-5555).
- Encourage your child to use StudentNet on a regular basis to check academic records, use the online textbooks, and explore the many other resources it has to offer
- Visit <a href="www.philasd.org/offices/studentnet">www.philasd.org/offices/studentnet</a> and click on the Resource Materials page to download documents (such as the ILP Guide and SMART Goals) that will help you work with your child
- Register for your own account in FamilyNet to access your child's academic records and view his/her ILP. You will need your child's date of birth and student ID number to register.
