For that reason, we encourage you to listen to your son or daughter as well as discuss with them their feelings and reactions to this loss. Sudden death is always painful to understand, and your child may experience signs of stress. Some of these signs include:

- Inability to concentrate
- Irritability or increased aggression
- Isolation and withdrawal from normal activities and friends
- Guilt
- Fearfulness and worries
- Changes in sleep or appetite
