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Parent:

Last spring the School District of Philadelphia administered the Naglieri Nonverbal Ability Test (NNAT) to all 2nd graders. The NNAT is ONE measure of potential gifted eligibility. Students who are gifted demonstrate abilities significantly above the level expected for their age in one or more areas. The NNAT assists in identifying strengths in reasoning and problem solving ability not related to reading level or language.

Your child scored in the Superior range which is above the level expected for your child's age when compared with other children in your child's age group across the country. A copy of your child's report is attached.

We are recommending that your child be evaluated for potential gifted eligibility. This review will involve:

- A review of your child's academic progress
- A behavior/characteristics checklist completed by the teacher(s)
- A psychological evaluation conducted by the OCIA psychologist
