Gonorrhea and chlamydia are <u>sexually transmitted diseases</u> (STDs) that you get from having <u>unprotected sex</u> with another person (penis in vagina, mouth on penis, mouth on vagina, penis in butt, foreplay). These two diseases are very common among teenagers in Philadelphia.

Most cases of gonorrhea and chlamydia have **no signs or symptoms** so the only way to know if you are infected is if you take a test.

The test is **confidential**. We follow HIPPA laws, so we cannot give any of your information out to your family, teachers, or boyfriend/girlfriend.


The test is **optional**. You do not have to pee in the cup, but you must participate filling out the white sheet and walking into the bathroom.

TESTING PROCEDURE

- 1. Each student receives a brown bag.
- 2. Each student fills out the white slip.
- 3. Each student puts the white slip back in the bag.
- 4. Each student must enter the bathroom.
- 5. **IF** you want to take the test:

Urinate into the cup, screw the lid on, put the cup in the brown bag with the white slip.

- 6. We will collect all brown bags when you exit the bathroom.
- 7. Test results are ready in 2 weeks.
