What is the Seal?

The Seal of Biliteracy is an award given by a school, district, or county office of education in recognition of students who have studied and attained proficiency in two or more languages by high school graduation.



The students who meet the criteria described in this brochure regarding their proficiency in both, English Language and a Language other than English. Seals of Biliteracy are intended for all students who master standard academic English and any other language.



The goal is to help students recognize that being biliterate is an asset and to provide motivation for them to succeed in school. Another important objective is to connect bilingual students with potential employers. Being biliterate can often translate into tangible employment benefits.

English Language Criteria:



Overall GPA of 3.0+ with "B" or higher in all English credit bearing classes from 10th through 12th grade.

And

"Proficient" on Literature Keystone or 4.5+ on most recent ACCESS test (high school version of test).

You will have 3 different pathways to demonstrate your proficiency on the language of your preference. You must choose one pathway and meet all the requirements before graduation.
