Despite the ongoing funding challenges facing the School District of Philadelphia (SDP), last year was an incredibly successful one for PAS, as evidenced by the numerous accomplishments of our students and staff. In order to continue this tradition of high student and teacher achievement, we need the support of the entire community. Please consider helping PAS in whatever way you can.

Support can take the form of financial contributions, which allow the school to participate in enrichment programs that would otherwise not be possible. Thanks to your donations, PAS has maintained a rich arts and music program.
